Patient with Commercial Insurance	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Insurance plan formulary alternative. • Manufacturer copay card (pay close attention to max savings with each card). • Discount card programs. • Human insulin product (ex. Novolin R, Novolin N) or generic insulin (glargine, lispro, aspart) or biosimilar insulin (ex. Basaglar®, Rezvoglar®, Semglee®). • Manufacturer specific programs
Patient with Medicaid	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Insurance plan formulary alternative. • Prior authorization process.
Patient with No Insurance	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Manufacturer PAP if conditions met. • Insulin Valyou savings program. • My \$99 insulin. • Human insulin product (ex. Novolin R, Novolin N) or biosimilar insulin. • Referral to site that offers Pharmacy with 340b status/HRSA registration
