<b>Patient with Commercial Insurance</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Insurance plan formulary alternative.</li> <li>Manufacturer copay card (pay close attention to max savings with each card).</li> <li>Discount card programs.</li> <li>Human insulin product (ex. Novolin R, Novolin N) or generic insulin (glargine, lispro, aspart) or biosimilar insulin (ex. Basaglar®, Rezvoglar®, Semglee®).</li> <li>Manufacturer specific programs</li> </ul>
